- 8) Sivan Hoil at Alambalam, Tiruchy District.
- 9) Agastheswarar temple at Kyuzandi, Tiruchy District.
- 10) Brahm Inscriptions at Velamudhalapuram, Tiruchy District.
- 11) Caves at Arinjammal in Arittapatti, Nadurai District.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas the State Government are of opinion that the ancient monuments specified in the Schedule below requires protection under the Tamil Nadu Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1966 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1966);

It is, therefore, proposed to declare the aforesaid monuments as protected monuments under sub-section (3) of section 3 of the said Act and the proposal is hereby published for general information as required by sub-section (1) of the said section;

Notice is hereby given that the proposal will be taken up for consideration on or after the date of expiry of two months from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received with respect thereto from any person before the date of expiry will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objections or suggestions, if any, should be addressed to the Secretary to the Government of Tamil Nadu, Education Department, Fort St. George, Madras.
