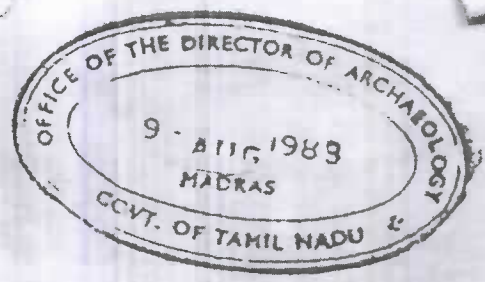

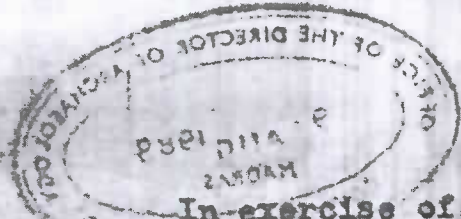
ORDER:

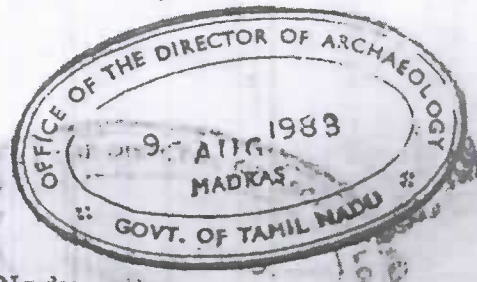
