- 6) Siva Temple at Sivanuram, Chingleput District.
- 7) Sculptures at Chengalmedu at Sengalendacholapuram, Tiruchy District.
- 8) Sivan Koll at Alarbakkar, Tiruchy District.
- 9) Agastheeswarar temple at Arungudi, Tiruchy District.
- 10) Brahmi Inscriptions at Velurudhimalayan, Tiruchy District.
- 11) Caves at Arinjankudi in Tamil Nadu District.

The Director of Archaeology has not submitted a draft notification regarding the aforesaid monuments as protected monuments under sub-section (1) of the Tamil Nadu Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1966 (Tamil Nadu Act 35 of 1966) for the approval of the Government.

It is, therefore, proposed to declare the aforesaid monuments as protected monuments under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the said Act and the proposal is hereby published for general information as required by sub-section (1) of the said section;

Notice is hereby given that the proposal will be taken up for consideration on or after the date of expiry of two months from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received with respect thereto from any person before the date of expiry will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objections or suggestions, if any, should be addressed to the Secretary to the Government of Tamil Nadu, Education Department, Fort St. George, Madras.
